## Pastor's Report

When we were to select a topic for this issue of 'Kirkebladet' the subject was easy: It had to have something to do with Her Majesty Queen Margrethe. Not only because she decided to abdicate on the 14<sup>th</sup> of January after 52 years on the throne, but also because we will be celebrating her birthday in April and because she – before she abdicated – was the protector of DSUK.

As a protector of DSUK her role was to engage in the work and broaden the knowledge of the organization. A role she took very seriously – not only in Denmark, but around the world as well. In Vancouver we are so lucky that we have a testimony of this: Our Altar Rug. As you can see on the picture to the right, she embroidered three

golden stitches into it when she visited our church back in 1991.

It was her second visit to the church. Her first visit dates to back to 1967 – five years before she was appointed Queen of Denmark. With her abdication she also stepped down as protector of DSUK. A successor has not yet been appointed but it will be interesting to see who (if any) of the royalties will take over the role after her. One thing is certain: Here in Vancouver, we will always greet any Danish royalty with open arms as they are an inseparable part of our roots, culture, and organization.

On the front page of this issue of Kirkebladet you can see the tremendous crowd, when Queen Margrethe's son, His Majesty King Frederik X was proclaimed king of Denmark. Due to my recent holiday, I was lucky to be able to participate in the celebration. It was a huge experience. People waved their flags all over – even from the windows – and it is estimated that 300,000 people were on the streets of Copenhagen that day. One thing is sure: I have never seen that many people in the city center. People came from all over Denmark, and everyone seemed to be happy and 'united' – a word that starts the newly appointed king's royal motto: "United, committed, for the Kingdom of Denmark." May he be as good a king for Denmark as Queen Margrethe was a queen.

# Obituary – Lilly Lava Hildebrandt

*November 9, 1928 – December 17, 2023*
