Now my entire family cannot only see a picture of my favorite donut. They

have all tasted it. Now my entire family cannot only imagine how my work in the Church is, they have seen me there 'in action'.

The privilege of having them be able to come visit me has made me reflect upon how it must have been for many of you who came over before videocalls and emails, online florists, or even airplanes. The only thing you had to connect you with yours was slow mail or a phone – one that not only cost a lot to use but certainly could not take pictures as well. It cannot have been easy leaving family behind and not knowing when, how and if one were to connect ever again. Nor can it have been easy to describe your everyday life.

Despite the hindrances, many of you stayed in touch with your family though. And stayed in touch with Denmark. Many of you tried to explain the wonders over here. Not necessarily to persuade people to visit, but because it was important to you to be understood by family and friends, and by Denmark. At least that is what my reflections have led me to believe. What is of importance is not all the wonders of the world, what is of importance is fellow human beings like family, friends, the people with whom one can connect. Connect and be understood by heart.

This summer I connected. That is why I right now feel blessed.

On Monday, September 21, Tina Christiansen is playing the organ for us in the church. She is a very active concert organist with an extensive international career as a soloist, chamber musician and accompanist. She has played extensively throughout Scandinavia, and Northern, Southern and Eastern Europe, even Russia. Tina has played solo concerts on some of Europe's largest organs, such as at St Paul's Cathedral and Westminster Abbey in London, Riga Dom in Latvia, Kaliningrad Cathedral in Russia and St Florian Stiftsbasilika (International Bruckner Festival) in Austria.

Tina has played concerts with several Danish orchestras and has played the world premieres of music by more than 20 composers from Denmark and abroad.

Tina is the organist and director of music at Ansgar's Church in Odense (DK), and she is the initiator and artistic director of the Odense International Organ Festival.

The College and Career Group continues to meet up throughout the year, most recently they attended the fireworks at Vanier Park in Vancouver.

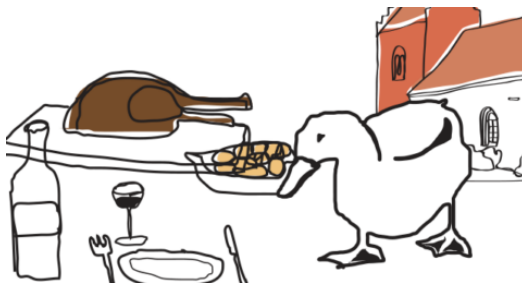
